

# Services Offered At West Chester Medical Center

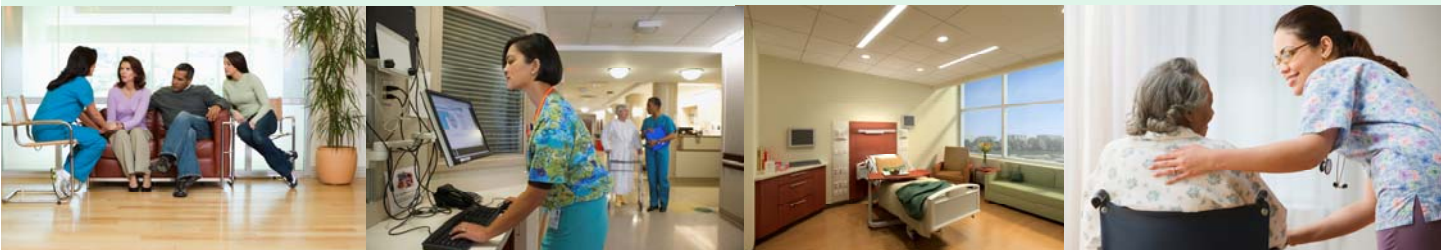
*At West Chester Medical Center, we offer the latest in medical technology along with skilled, experienced and compassionate health care providers who help you get better and get home to your family.*

## **West Chester Medical Center features:**

- **A full-service emergency department** with 28 private treatment rooms. There are no large bays of beds separated only by thin curtains – every patient has his or her own room with a door. Bedside registration allows you to go straight to your room and start getting examined and treated, while a staff member collects your registration information.
- **Hospitalists and intensivists** – These are physicians who specialize in hospital and critical care medicine, and who treat patients throughout the hospital experience when your regular physician can't be there.

## **We offer the following services:**

- **Cardiology** – the diagnosis and treatment of disorders and diseases of the heart, such as congenital heart defects, coronary artery disease, heart failure, and valvular heart disease.
- **Endoscopy** – examination of the inside of the body using a fiberoptic, flexible instrument called an endoscope.
- **Gastrointestinal services** – such as colonoscopy, to diagnose and treat digestive diseases of the esophagus, stomach and intestines.

### *Services, continued...*

- **Inpatient and outpatient diagnostic imaging** – also known as radiology. This includes X-ray and CT Scan.
- **Intensive care unit** – an area of the hospital where a patient will be monitored closely for a critical medical condition.
- **Interventional radiology** – including a cardiac cath lab.
- **Nephrology** – the study and treatment of the kidneys and kidney disease.
- **Neurology** – deals with disorders of the nervous system; for example, migraines, epilepsy, stroke, multiple sclerosis, and more.
- **Oncology and hematology** – the diagnosis and treatment of cancer and blood diseases, such as leukemia.
- **Orthopedics** – surgical and non-surgical treatment of bone and joint trauma, such as sports injuries, degenerative diseases, infections, and congenital conditions.
- **Perioperative Services** – including general surgery, vascular surgery, cardiac catheterization, outpatient surgery, and recovery
- **Physical and occupational therapy** – the use of exercise and movement therapy to prevent, treat and rehabilitate injuries caused by injury, aging, disease or environmental factors
- **Primary care** – physicians who act as a first point of consultation for all patients.
- **Pulmonology** – deals with diseases of the lungs and the respiratory tract, also known as respiratory medicine.
- **Urology** – focuses on the urinary tracts of men and women, and on the reproductive systems of males.
- **Women's health services** including a dedicated women's imaging center
